Constitution 2056**

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Preamble

The abundant water resource occupying important place in improving economic and social status of Nepal kingdom, existing irrigation water effective conservation, development of policy accordingly discussion and suggestion provided by the irrigation users and implementing for the benefit of targeted community, forest and environment conservation for sustainable agriculture development, providing necessary and essential irrigation facility, as an organized association directly involved with irrigation users community for sustainable agriculture development and effective networking with the government and non government organization involved in irrigation development,

Multi-purpose programme of water resources such as: agriculture modernization, research base agriculture as well as professional agriculture and integrating agriculture development for poverty reduction of the users,

Maintaining environmental equilibrium through local awareness, effective participation of women and deprived community, uniting all the irrigation water users association for the integrated water resource development through strengthening the institutional capacity of the community, this federation is registered as per the **Sangh Sanstha Ain 2034** (Company Registration Act, 1978) and National Federation of Irrigation Water Users Association Constitution 2056 is developed and implemented as per the Act.

Section-1
PRELIMINARY

1) Brief Name, Address and Initial:

- 1.1) This Federation is named National Federation of Irrigation Water User's Association, Nepal. In abbreviation it is called NFIWUAN.
- 1.2) NFIWUAN Office: The central office of Federation will be located in Kathmandu district
- 1.3) This constitution is implemented by date approved by the concerned agency.

2) National Federation of Irrigation Water Users Association, Nepal

- 2.1) National Federation of Irrigation Water Users Association, Nepal is an independent, autonomous, self governed, organized, social, non political, charitable organization.
- 2.2) It can purchase, sales, use and mortgage moveable and immovable property.
- 2.3) The federation on the behalf of the organization can file petition against other parties, and other parties can also file petition against it.
- 2.4) Regional co-ordination committee and each established District committee are the vital component of this federation.

- 3) NFIWUAN Stamp and Logo:** As per the logo of the Federation attached in Annex 1, the logo of the federation is circular with the map of Nepal inside the circle, in the middle portion of the map there is a wheat stand, and above it there is the drop of sprinkled water, the wheat stand is supported by two hands, and exteriorly around the circle it is noted National Federation of Irrigation Water Users Association, Nepal, 2056.

4) Definition:

Unless the subject or content otherwise requires:

- 4.1) Federation means National Federation of Irrigation Water Users Association, Nepal established an accordingly under this constitution.
- 4.2) Constitution means National Federation of Irrigation Water Users Association, Nepal constitution 2056.
- 4.3) Water Users committee are those established with an objective for the maintenance and operation of irrigation system. These committees are registered as per the law.
- 4.4) Irrigated areas are those areas that are within the system and irrigated by the medium of water users committee.
- 4.5) System means those developed infrastructure for the irrigation purpose and it incorporates all the component of the irrigated area and this word also denotes to those systems that are already developed and are in operation.
- 4.6) Farmers managed irrigation systems are those system that are developed by the farmers with their own knowledge and experience and are in operation. These irrigation system are either registered in concerned agency or they are operated by the farmers with own rules developed by the group of farmers without any external interference.

- 4.7) National executive committee means the members elected from the National Assembly.
- 4.8) Advisory committee means the experienced and intellectual member selected by the National executive committee.
- 4.9) National secretariat committee means President, Vice-President, General Secretary, Secretary, Treasurer and 4 other members selected from the National executive committee (2 female candidate is compulsory). The National secretariat committee consists of 9 members.
- 4.10) Members are those Irrigation Users Associations that have taken membership as per this constitution.
- 4.11) Former President means immediate out going president.

Section-2 Goal and Objectives

- 5) **Goal and Objectives:** NFIWUAN Goal and Objectives are as follows:
 - 5.1) **Goal:** The Goal of NFIWUAN is to associate all the irrigation water users association and farmers managed irrigation system existing in the country through mass participation and involving them in decision making process for progress and self dependent.
 - 5.2) **Objectives:** The above goal of the federation is fulfilled on the basis of the objectives of the federation listed below:
 - 5.2.1) To strengthen the capacity and develop a leadership in irrigation water users association as an organized irrigation user and establish a mutual co-operation with His Majesty's Government and related organization,
 - 5.2.2) To educate and aware irrigation users on national and international water related law and policy through training, workshop, seminar and group discussion,
 - 5.2.3) On the basis of His Majesty's Government policy on participatory irrigation management irrigation water users association are involved in the every step of operation and management of system for the sustainable development of irrigation system,
 - 5.2.4) Irrigation Water Users Association are encouraged for the multiple uses of water resources and for the integrated solution of water resources related issues,
 - 5.2.5) To encourage irrigation water use association for the active representation of female in every organizational structure of the federation and active participation female in each and every activity of the federation,
 - 5.2.6) To encourage irrigation water users association for the active representation of dalit, marginalized and ethnic communities in every organizational structure of the federation,
 - 5.2.7) To establish federation as one of the key representatives of all the irrigation water users for advocating on the rights of the irrigation users and provide necessary advice and recommendations to His Majesty's Government and other relevant

- organization on the formulation, reformation and implementation of irrigation law, policy, plans and programmes,
- 5.2.8) To conduct study, research and publication on irrigation and agriculture related issues for the effective management and sustainable utilization of water resources,
 - 5.2.9) To increase the institutional capacity of the Regional co-ordination committee and District Federation,
 - 5.2.10) All the mentioned above objectives are implemented by taking permission of His Majesty's Government of Nepal existing policy and law.

Section-3 **Membership Related Arrangement**

- 6) **Membership:**
 - 6.1) Irrigation Water Users Association registered as per the irrigation policy, laws and regulation and farmers managed irrigation system that are operated and managed by the farmers, and either registered or have some written description or have no any written description, and are based on the defacto norms and values can be the members of this Federation as per this constitution.
 - 6.2) General membership fee is Nepalese rupees 100/- (One hundred) only.
 - 6.3) National working committee can provide honorary membership to any experienced and intellectual Nepali citizen working in the field of irrigation and water resource management.
 - 6.4) General members should renew their membership in each fiscal year. The renewable fee is Nepalese rupees 50/- (Fifty). The members not renewing their general membership for the first year can renewed their membership in the second year by paying Nepalese rupees 100/- (One hundred) and delayed fine Nepalese rupees 25/- (Twenty five). The general member not renewing their membership by the end of the second year those memberships are automatically ceased.

Section-4 **Organizational Structure and its Arrangement**

- 7) **Organization:**
 - 7.1) National Federation of Irrigation Water Users Association, Nepal organizational structure are as follows:
 - i) National Assembly
 - ii) National Council
 - iii) National Executive Committee
 - iv) National Secretariat
 - v) Regional Co-Ordination Committee
 - vi) District Committee
 - vii) Irrigation Water Users Association

- 7.2) **National Assembly:** National Assembly is the chief body of this federation. The national assembly is conducted in every 4 years. If the federation is unable to conduct the national assembly within 4 years due to some reasonable facts based on the decision of national executive committee it can be extended for a 6 month.
- 7.3) **National Assembly Formation:** The National Assembly consists of following representatives:
- i) All the existing national executive committee members,
 - ii) From the district committee affiliating 50 irrigation water users association represents two members (1 male candidate and 1 female candidate),
 - iii) From the district committee affiliating 51 to 150 irrigation water users association represents 4 members (1 dalit, 1 indigenous/marginalized/ethnic communities, 1 female and 1 others),
 - iv) From the district committee affiliating 151 and above irrigation water users committee represents 6 members (2 female, 1 dalit and rest others).
 - v) Irrigation system registered in related sector and members of the federation with command area of 2000 ha in terai and 500 ha in hill represents president or a representatives selected by the system in the absence of president.
- 7.4) The name list of the representatives from different irrigation system and district committee for the national assembly should be submitted before 30 days of national assembly to the central secretariat.
- 7.5) **National Assembly Duties, Responsibility and Rights:** The duties, responsibility and rights of National Assembly are as follows:
- i) To conduct election of National executive committee,
 - ii) Formulate vision, policy and strategy to fulfill the goal and objective of the federation,
 - iii) Develop work plan and give necessary direction to the National council and National executive committee for its implementation,
 - iv) Discussion on the proposal proposed by the National executive committee and its ratification,
 - v) To give necessary direction to the President, Vice-President, General Secretary, Secretary, Treasurer and Members of the National executive committee,
 - vi) Formation of account committee.
- 7.6) If any district committee identifies any proposal for the discussion in National Assembly then district committee should register such proposal, issues along with the name of representatives. The federation will form a sub committee for the selection of such proposals and accept or reject the proposals for discussion in the National Assembly.
- 7.7) **National Assembly Venue and Chairmanship:**
- i) National Assembly is conducted under the chairmanship of President of National executive committee or under the chairmanship of Vice-President in the absence of President.

ii) The date, venue and time of the National Assembly are as per the decision made by the National executive committee.

7.8) **Special National Assembly:** Out of the total representatives of National Assembly if 1/3rd of the representatives realized for the special national assembly then they can called a special national assembly through a written statement. The Federation should call a special national assembly within a three month. Special national assembly cannot be called for a period of one year after the national assembly. The process of special national assembly for regional co-ordination committee and district committee are same as mentioned above.

8) **National Council:**

8.1) National council is conducted each year except the same year of the national assembly and the last year of the national assembly to be conducted. The date, venue and time for the national assembly are fixed by the national executive committee. The same process is followed for the district council.

8.2) **National Council Formation:** National Council consists of following representatives:

i) There will be 2 representatives from each district committee (1 female candidate and 1 president). In the absence of president the candidate selected by the district executive committee will represent in the national council.

ii) All the members of the National executive committee.

8.3) **National Council Duties, Responsibility and Rights:**

i) To discuss on the Progress report and Budget report presented by the national executive committee and forwarded for ratification,

ii) Discuss on the yearly policy, plan, programme and budget as well as forwarding it for ratification,

iii) Ratification of essential regulation and by regulation,

iv) Give necessary directions to the National executive committee.

8.4) National council is conducted under the chairmanship of president of National executive committee or under the chairmanship of vice-president in the absence of president.

8.5) If the members of the National council do not agree on the report or proposal presented by the National executive committee for the ratification then the proposals or report are ratified based on the decision of majority of members. If there will be equal vote than the final decision is done by the president.

9) **National executive committee:**

9.1) National executive committee consists of following members

i) President -1, Vice president -1, General secretary- 1, Secretary-1, Treasurer-1. All these executive members are elected from the National Assembly,

- ii) 5 female elected candidate from five development region (1 candidate from each development region).
- iii) 14 elected members from 14 zones (1 member from each zone).
- iv) Out of the total representatives of National assembly 1 elected dalit candidate.
- v) 4 members selected by the National executive committee (2 members from ethnic caste, indigenous and marginalized community and 2 members from experienced irrigation water users association. In this selection 1 female candidate is compulsory).

9.2) **National Secretariat Committee Formation:** National secretariat committee consists of President, Vice-President, General Secretary, Secretary, Treasurer and four members from the National executive committee. National executive committee consists of 9 members in which five vital post are mandatory while the other four members (2 female members are compulsory) are selected by the National executive committee. National secretariat committee is guided as per the direction provided by the National executive committee.

9.3) **National Executive Committee Duties, Responsibility and Rights:** National executive committee duties, responsibility and rights are as follows:

- i) To perform the activities as per the direction provided by the National Assembly and National Council,
- ii) To prepare the income and expenditure report and present it on the National Council for ratification,
- iii) To prepare the policy, plan and programme and present on the National assembly and National council for ratification and implement as per the direction provided by the National assembly and National council,
- iv) To actively involve in fulfilling the objectives of the Federation,
- v) To employ the office staffs as per the requirements,
- vi) To select and nominate the advisory committee,
- vii) To prepare and implement the required rules, regulation, by regulation in order to fulfill the objectives of the federation,
- viii) To select the auditor and fixed his/her salary.

9.4) The meeting of the National executive committee should be held 2 times a year. In case if the National Secretariat seeks the necessity of the meeting of the National executive committee than it can be called at any time.

9.5) The date, venue and time of meeting of National executive committee should be informed before 15 days of meeting to all the members of National executive committee.

9.6) In the absence of President the meeting of the National executive committee is chaired by Vice-President and in the absence of Vice-President out of the members of National executive committee the meeting is chaired by the elder member.

9.7) If any members in the meeting of National executive committee want to propose some special proposal/issues than such proposal should be registered in the National secretariat before the meeting of National executive committee.

10) **National Executive Committee Executive Members and Members Duties, Responsibility and Rights:**

President

- i) To chaired the National Assembly, National Council, and National Executive committee meeting and to give a final vote in any decision if there exists an equal vote between the members of the National Executive Committee,
- ii) To watch out all the activities of the Federation,
- iii) To provide a leadership in all the activities for fulfilling the objectives of the Federation,
- iv) To represent the Federation,
- v) To specify the duties, responsibility of executive members and members of the National Executive Committee as per the requirements,
- vi) To follow the guide lines obtained from the National Assembly and National Council for fulfilling the objectives of the Federation.

Vice-President

- i) In the absence of President perform all the activities of President,
- ii) To perform the work assigned by the Federation,
- iii) To help in fulfilling the objectives of the Federation.

General Secretary

- i) To call a meeting of National Executive Committee as per the direction of President,
- ii) Keep a record of discussion and decision of National Assembly, National Council and meeting of National Executive Committee,
- iii) The decision made by National Assembly, National Council and National Executive Committee should be informed to all the members,
- iv) The proposal that is presented in the National Assembly and National Council should be analyzed by the National Executive Committee. Such proposal should be presented in the National Executive Committee for ratification,
- v) To perform daily activities of the Federation,
- vi) To watch out the activities of the office staff and regulate them,
- vii) To perform the other works as per assigned by the Federation,
- viii) To help in fulfilling the objectives of the Federation.

Secretary

- i) In the absence of General Secretary perform all the activities of General Secretary,
- ii) To perform other work as per assigned by the Federation,
- iii) To help in the work of General Secretary,
- iv) To help in fulfilling the objectives of the Federation.

Treasurer

- i) To take the responsibility of Federation fund,
- ii) To prepare and present the income and expenditure report of the Federation in the National executive committee for ratification and forwarded to the National Council and presented in the National Assembly,
- iii) To initiate for the fund raising of the Federation,
- iv) To maintain and update the account of the Federation,
- v) To perform other works as per assigned by the Federation,
- vi) To help in fulfilling the objectives of the Federation.

Members

- i) To attend in the meeting of the Federation and perform active participation in discussion and decision,
- ii) To perform other works as per assigned by the Federation,
- iii) To help in fulfilling the objectives of the Federation.

11) Regional Co-Ordination Committee:

For the formation of regional co-ordination committee the following are selected as a representative:

- i) The representatives of National Assembly from the districts of related development region,
- ii) Regional Co-ordination Committee executive members and members.

11.1) Regional Co-ordination committee consists of 9 to 19 members. It includes President-1, Vice-President-1, Secretary-1, Treasurer-1 and other members. Regional co-ordination committee should include at least a single member from each district. The duration of the members of Regional Co-ordination committee is of four years. Due to some special reason the duration of regional co-ordination committee can be extended for 2 month. The duration can be extended after the agreement provided by the National executive committee.

11.2) **Regional Co-ordination Committee Duties, Responsibility and Rights:** The duties, responsibility and rights of regional co-ordination committee are as follows:

- i) To work in order to fulfill the objectives of the federation,
- ii) To perform the work and responsibility assigned by the National executive committee,
- iii) To work as a network between the District executive committee and National executive committee,
- iv) To perform the work mentioned in the regulation.

11.3) Regional co-ordination committee organizational structure, duties, responsibility and rights, resource collection and mobilization, networking between National executive committee and District executive committee, meeting and its

arrangement, formation of advisory committee and other essential arrangement are done as per mentioned in the regulation.

12) **District Executive Committee Formation:** District executive committee is formed incorporating 11 irrigation water users association of district (irrigation water users association registered in relevant sector or farmers managed irrigation system). These irrigation water users association and district executive committee should be member of the federation. The duration of the members of district executive committee is of 4 years. If due to any special reason the district assembly cannot be conducted within a time then the period can be extended for 6 months based on the decision of the majority of the members of the district executive committee.

12.1) **District Assembly:** The following representatives are represented in the district assembly

- i) District executive committee executive members and members,
- ii) Irrigation water users association with command area of 500 ha represents 2 representatives (1 male and 1 female) and irrigation water users association with command area more than 500 ha represents each 1 representative in each 500 ha. The irrigation water users association must be the member of federation.

Note: In place of female representative no male candidate can be represented.

12.2) District assembly should be conducted in the presence of member of National executive committee (at least 1 member of National executive committee should be present during the district assembly).

12.3) **District Council:** District council is conducted each year except the same year of the district assembly and the last year of the district assembly to be conducted. The following are the representatives in the district council:

- i) District executive committee executive members and members,
- ii) There will be two representatives from each irrigation water users association (1 male and 1 female). The irrigation water users association must be the members of the district federation.
- iii) Irrigation water users association with command area more than 500 ha represents each 1 representative in each 500 ha.

12.4) Each district executive committee should prepare a progress report and policy and programme of coming year. These should be submitted each year to the National secretariat within three months after the end of the fiscal year.

12.5) District assembly, District executive committee, District council organizational structure, duties, responsibility and rights, members nomination, resource collection and mobilization, relation with national executive committee, formation of district advisory committee, meeting of district executive committee and its arrangement and other essential arrangement are made as per mentioned in the regulation.

- 13) **Advisory Committee:** National executive committee will form an 11 member's advisory committee. The advisory committee will provide necessary suggestion to fulfill the objectives of the federation. The advisory committee will support the activities of the National executive committee. The meeting of the advisory committee is called as per the need. Former president is the ex-officio member of the advisory committee.
- 13.1) **Advisory Committee Duties, Responsibility and Rights:** The main function of the national, regional and district level advisory committee of the federation is to provide necessary suggestion, guide line and direction for policy, strategy, planning and programme of the federation in order to fulfill the objectives of the federation.
- 13.2) **Department and Subcommittee Formation:** To fulfill the objectives of the federation National executive committee, Regional co-ordination committee and District executive committee can form different department and subcommittee. These committees are formed out of the executive members and members. The members are assigned to handle the different department with specified task.

Section-5

Qualification, Resignation, Post vacant, No Confidence Motion, Post Fulfillment and Code of Conduct

- 14) **Qualification, Resignation, Post vacant, No Confidence Motion, Post Fulfillment and Code of Conduct:** The following arrangements are made for this purpose:
- 14.1) **Qualification:** The following qualifications are required for the executive member and members of national assembly, national council and national executive committee:
- i) A Nepali citizen above 18 years of age and members of irrigation water users association or system,
 - ii) The members should not be charged of mis management of any kind of budget of government and non government organization,
 - iii) No mental disturbance,
 - iv) No any charge imposed by the court.
- 14.2) **Resignation and its Approval:** The President of the National executive committee should submit a resignation with a written statement to the National executive committee but the executive members and members should submit a resignation to the president and it is approved by the president. The same process is followed for the executive members and member's resignation of regional co-ordination committee and district executive committee.

- 14.3) **Post Vacant:** National assembly, National council and National executive committee executive members and members post remain vacant due to the following conditions:
- i) Due to death,
 - ii) Written resignation and its approval,
 - iii) If any member remains absence in the meeting of National executive committee regularly for 3 times without any pre information,
 - iv) Mental disturbance.
- 14.4) **No Confidence Motion:** If there is any disbelief with any executive member or members of the national executive committee than out of the total representatives of national assembly 25 percent representatives should come up with a written statement in the national executive committee. If that disbelief is against the president than it is handled by the vice president and if that is against the other members than it is handled by the president. The written statement registered in the national executive committee is discussed in the meeting and special meeting of the representatives of national assembly should be called within three months. The no confidence motion should be approved by the two third members of the national assembly. But before approving the no confidence motion one should be at least provided chance to put his/her views against the charge.
- 14.5) **Post Fulfillment:** In case due to certain reason if the post of the executive members remains vacant than the post is fulfilled by nominating from the remaining executive member or members of national executive committee but in case of members the candidate must be nominated from same zone or district from where he/she is elected.
- 14.6) **Code of Conduct:** National assembly, National council, National executive committee executive member and members as well as office staffs should follow the following code of conduct:
- i) Submission of membership fee and renewable fee, and initiate to submit,
 - ii) Perform the activities and show the behavior as per the responsibility and post,
 - iii) Always involve in fulfilling the objectives of the federation,
 - iv) Not to break the secrecy of the federation,
 - v) To play an effective role in strengthening the ability of the federation and fulfilling the objectives of the federation,
 - vi) Follow the constitution, regulation, by-regulation and decision of the federation.

Section-6

Election Related Arrangement

- 15) **Election Related Arrangement:** The following arrangement are made for conducting the election of the federation,
- 15.1) National Assembly representative can only be a candidate for the post of executive member or member of National executive committee.

- 15.2) The candidate should submit the proposal including one proposer and one supporter representing national general assembly to be the candidate for member or other post of national executive committee. No representative of national assembly can be the proposer or supporter of more than one candidate.
- 15.3) To select a new leadership in National executive committee from National assembly the national executive committee will form a 6 member's election committee in a meeting before the national assembly. Out of the 6 members 1 co-coordinator and 5 members election committee is formed. The member of the election committee is not allowed to be a candidate in the election. The same above mentioned process is followed for the regional co-ordination committee and district assembly.
- 15.4) All the necessary arrangement as well essential rules and direction for the execution of election is managed by the election committee,
- 15.5) While selecting the executive members and members there should be mass agreement between the representatives of the national/district assembly. If there exists a disagreement between the representatives then there will be election on the respective post in which there is no mass agreement. The candidate should receive a minor majority to be an elected candidate. If there is an equal vote between the candidate than it is declared by a lottery.
- 15.6) In the National executive committee for the post of president a candidate cannot be elected for two consecutive years. In case of Regional coordination committee a candidate elected as a president cannot nominate for the same post in the later years.
- 15.7) All the national executive member and members takes oath with former immediate outgoing president and in the absence of president with coordinator of election committee as per mentioned in the Annex-2. All the nominated members take oath with present working president.
- 15.8) **Hand over:** Former outgoing national executive committee should handover all the essentialities within 30 days after the execution of national assembly to the newly formed/elected national executive committee. The same above mentioned process is followed for the regional coordination committee and district executive committee.

Section-7

Financial, Administration, Auditing and Office Staffs Related Arrangement

- 16) **Financial arrangement:** The financial arrangements are done as per the following:

- 16.1) **Fund:** The federation will manage its separate fund and in this fund the following money are collected:
- i) Money collected from membership fee,
 - ii) The money received as donation and help from different national and international level governmental and nongovernmental organization,
 - iii) The donation and gift money received by the federation,
 - iv) All the money gained by the federation.
- 16.2) The selected expenses identified by the national assembly, national council and national executive committee are done from this fund.
- 16.3) The federation will have a separate non-expendable fund.
- 16.4) As per the decision of national executive committee the district executive committee can collect money from the irrigation water users association. Out of the fund collected the district executive committee should send 25% to the national executive committee, 15% to the regional coordination committee and remaining 60% is kept by the district executive committee itself. Out of the 25% received by the federation 15% is deposited in the national non expendable fund and remaining 10% is used for the management of office of the secretariat.
- 16.5) The federation will maintain a bank account. All the transaction of bank is operated by a signature of President/General secretary and Treasurer. The signature of treasurer is compulsory. In the absence of president to perform the daily activities as per the decision the transaction of bank is done by the combined signature of Treasurer and General Secretary.
- 17) **Account and Auditing:**
- 17.1) Each year National executive committee will nominate an auditor for auditing. The auditor should have an approved license of His Majesty's Government. The auditor once nominated for auditing is restricted for a year only.
- 17.2) All the accounts of federation are kept in a controlled supervision of Treasurer. For the ease, accessibility and transparency the accounts are maintained in double entry system of book keeping.
- 17.3) The Treasurer should present an audit report in the national assembly and national council.
- 17.4) Before auditing the account of the federation it should go through the internal audit by a 3 member committee formed by the national assembly or national council.
- 17.5) The duties, responsibility and rights of the account committee are based on the arrangement made in the administrative and financial regulation.

- 17.6) **Office Staffs Related Arrangement:** To effectively perform the daily activities of the federation as per the needs assessed by the national executive committee the office staff fulfillment committee can select and appoint the staffs.
- 17.7) The salary, per diem and other facilities to the office staffs are decided by the national executive committee.

Section-8 Miscellaneous

- 18) **Constitution Explanation:** The National executive committee has only rights to explain the arrangement made in this constitution. The subject to be explained must be ratified by the national assembly and it is implemented by the same date.
- 19) **Constitution Amendment:** If any arrangement made in this constitution is required to be amended than the national executive committee should forward in the national assembly for amendment. Out of the total representatives $2/3^{\text{rd}}$ of the members of the national assembly should ratify the amendment proposal and it is implemented after approved by related agency.
- 20) **Regulation and By-Regulation making Rights:** To fulfill the objectives of the federation national executive committee can make and implement essential regulation and by regulation.
- 21) If regional co-ordination committee identifies that the arrangement made by this constitution for national assembly, national council, national executive and national secretariat essential for implementation than such arrangement can be implemented by regional co-ordination committee and district committee under the provision arranged in this constitution.
- 22) **Repeal and Savings:** If any arrangements in this constitution are contradictory to the prevalent Nepal law than this arrangement dysfunction self.
- 23) If this federation dissolves than all the assets of this federation is under His Majesty's Government.
- 24) Before the amendment of this constitution all the activities performed are done under the arrangement made by this constitution.
